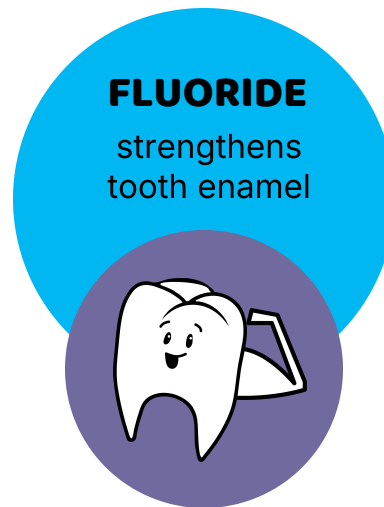




# How does Silver Diamine Fluoride work?
